

Dr. Krawczyk is an advisor and investor with Level 42 AI. He obtained his PhD in Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor with Dr. Leroy Townsend. After joining Gilead Sciences shortly after its founding, he worked on antisense research, aptamers, and small molecule antivirals. His research led to the publication of over 40 journal articles and patent applications.

Eventually Dr. Krawczyk joined the IP department, where he last held the position of Director of Patent Informatics where he oversaw the patent-based mining of intelligence data and provided expert guidance to attorneys prosecuting the company's patent applications. During this time, he obtained his MBA degree from Golden Gate University and a JD from Santa Clara University.

After leaving Gilead Sciences in 2013, Dr. Krawczyk began angel investing in Silicon Valley startups, as well as providing guidance with IP, regulatory, capital raising and commercialization efforts. He joined Level 42 AI in 2020 and is supporting them in their journey to reimagine the nature of wellbeing and aging.
